 - Certified Canine Fitness Trainer (**CCFT**)

After this initial training:

- Certified Canine Manual Therapist (**CCMT**)
- Canine Sports Medicine

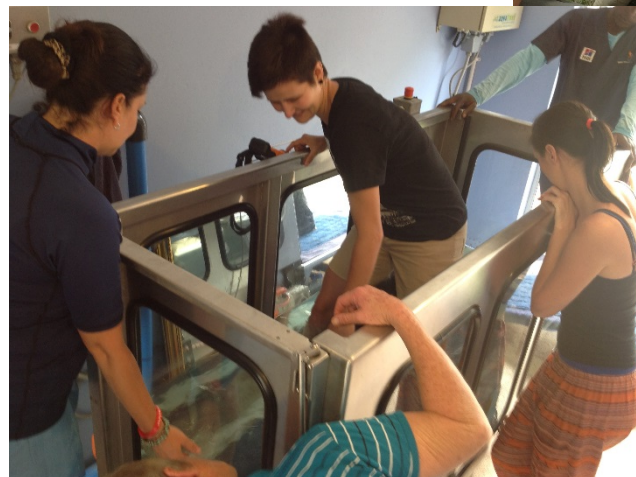
